# Launching Conference 6<sup>th</sup> Arab Watch Report on Economic and Social Rights 2023 with a focus on the Right to Health

Beirut, Lebanon July 7, 2023

The launching conference for the 6th Arab Watch Report on Economic and Social Rights 2023 aims to showcase the main findings of two years of research on the right to health in the Arab Region, conducted towards enhancing the role of civil society to hold accountable the social and economic policies that violate the right to health, and to inform policy and advocacy efforts at the national and regional levels towards achieving the right to health for all. The conference will feature a series of panels and discussions focusing on the issues covered in the regional, thematic, and national reports for the project. Discussions throughout the day will highlight the current situation of the right to health in the region, provide an overview of the main determinants of health, as well as discuss the main issues hindering the attainment of the right to health for all in a context of political, economic, and health crises.
